

Immunizations

Immunizations protect your child, your family, and the rest of the community from contracting potentially serious illnesses.

The following immunizations are required by the State of Wisconsin under the Student Immunization Law (chapter 252, Wis Stats. And DHS 144 Wis. Admin. Code).

Pre K (2 yrs through 4 yrs)	4 DTP/DTaP/DT		3 Polio	3 Hep B	1 MMR ²	1 Var ³
Grades K through 5	4 DTP/DTaP/DT ¹		4 Polio	3 Hep B	2 MMR ²	2 Var ³
Grades 6 through 12	4 DTP/DTaP/DT	1 Tdap	4 Polio	3 Hep B	2 MMR ²	2 Var ³

1. Your child must have received one dose after their 4th birthday
2. The first dose of MMR vaccine must have been received on or after your child's first birthday
3. Varicella vaccine is for chicken pox. A history of chickenpox disease is also acceptable

If your child does not have the necessary immunizations completed for their age/grade, please schedule your child's immunizations before the start of the school year. If you need assistance getting your child immunized, please refer to the local immunization clinics below or reach out to the School District Nurse for additional resources.
