Dear Parent(s):

Welcome to Wisconsin Heights Summer Program 2019! We hope to provide our students with an opportunity to be engaged in activities that will extend, enrich and reinforce their learning through the summer months.

Our Summer Program will take place at the **Middle School** with classes from 8:00 a.m.- 12:00 p.m., Monday-Thursday. There will be two summer school sessions. Session One will run from June 17th - July 3rd. During Session One we will be offering **enrichment and remedial classes** for students entering 1st - 8th grade. Classes will be held from 8:00-9:15, 9:30-10:45, and 10:45 – 12:00 with an all school snack/breakfast break from 9:15-9:30. You will find course descriptions in the summer school brochure. Session Two will run from July 8th - July 18th. Session Two will offer **only** remedial classes to students by teacher recommendation only. **New this year:** Kindergarten Jumpstart will be available for **either** Session One **OR** Session Two and will run from 8:00-12:00. Students may only sign up for **one** session.

**Registration will be ONLINE and classes will be filled on a FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE basis. Classes will fill up, so register early. Registration will open on April 4th at 6:00 p.m. and run through May 14th at 6:00 p.m.** It will be important to have your Family Access account activated **prior** to registration (see below for directions). You may also register via paper registration, but we cannot guarantee the classes will still be available.

We are excited about all our new enrichment options and hope you find something that will fill your child's summer with learning, discovery and fun. Please consider taking advantage of these opportunities by enrolling your child in our summer school program.

Summer Program brochures will be sent home on April 2nd.

**It is important to log into Skyward to make sure your student's Family Access account has been set up prior to registration.** See below for account set-up directions. Registration for classes **ONLINE** is on a **first come first serve basis**, classes will fill up so register early. **Registration opens April 4th at 6:00 p.m.** and will close on May 14th at 6:00 p.m.. See attached **Enrollment Directions** for further information on how to enroll. **Please note you must STILL fill out the paper registration form and return with payment to your school's office**

### Paper Registration:

Families may choose to use our paper registration process; however, **you will not be guaranteed your 1st choice of classes** because classes may fill up before registration materials are received and entered. To register by paper, fill out the registration form, include your payment and send back to your child's respective school.

### Out of district families:

Out of district families are encouraged to attend Wisconsin Heights Summer School program. Out of district families may register beginning April 11th. Please follow the paper registration directions **AND** contact Tammy Shaffer at [tshaffer@wisheights.k12.wi.us](mailto:tshaffer@wisheights.k12.wi.us) or call 767-2586 ext. 3005 to provide additional information needed to enroll your child. You will be asked to provide an immunization record and any medical or health information.

### Grade Levels:

### Confirmations:

You can view and print your schedule via our online registration process. Schedules may change due to cancellations. You will be notified by email or phone if a class is cancelled. Schedules will also be sent home in early June.

### Fees & Payments:

Please make payment for summer school classes ASAP after you have registered your child for classes and no later than May 14th. Return payment **and** the registration form **to your child's school or mail**

Wisconsin Heights Summer School, Mazomanie Elementary School, 314 Anne St., Mazomanie WI, 53560. Make checks payable to WHSD. **Be sure to include your child's full name in the memo on your check** to be sure we post the payment to the appropriate account.

### Bus Transportation:

Bus transportation is available for students from both elementary schools picking up at 7:45 a.m. and dropping students off at respective schools at 12:15 p.m. daily.

### Drop-off and Pick-up:

Parents should drop-off and pick-up promptly at 8:00 a.m and 12:00 p.m. at the Middle School location.

### Breakfast Program:

A "grab and go" style meal will be available mid-morning during snack break. The cost of a meal is \$1.60 per day. Items such as cereal, graham crackers and juice will be served. Milk will also be available to purchase at 50 cents per carton. Please make sure sufficient funds are available in your Food Service Account at the end of the year to cover your summer school breakfast charges. If you need to send additional funds, please send a **separate check** from the summer school registration fee.

### Snacks:

Students are encouraged to bring a nutritious snack to enjoy during the mid-morning break.

**Behavior Expectations:** All Summer School participants are expected to behave in a respectful, responsible and safe manner while attending any program in Wisconsin Heights School District. The summer school principal reserves the right to dismiss any participant when that participant's behavior interferes with the rights and safety of others and/or the participant's behavior is disruptive to the program.

Our Fundamentals classes require recommendation from your child's classroom teacher. Letter of recommendations are attached to this brochure.

- Click on the Skyward icon
- Click on "I am not a robot"
- Enter the email address that is under your name within Skyward
  - If you do not have an email address listed in Skyward or unsure, please contact Tammy Shaffer, District Registrar at [tshaffer@wisheights.k12.wi.us](mailto:tshaffer@wisheights.k12.wi.us) or call 767-2586 ext. 3005
- Click "submit"
- Watch your email for a message regarding resetting your password
- When you receive the email, click on the link provided
- You will be prompted to enter a new password (which will also contain your login information)
- Enter your password twice and click submit
- You now have your Family Access account set up and ready to go.

- Choose the "Arena Scheduling" tab
- Select "2019-20" under the student you wish to register for classes
- You will see the classes available for your students
- Under the "Fit" column, you will see "Yes" if the class is available. Under the column "Prd" is the period of the day that the class meets. There are 3 periods in a day meaning your child(ren) could take up to 3 classes per day.
- "Seats Avail" column indicates how many seats are left before the class is full. You will also see this information under the \*Ind" column, the a letter "F" means the class is full.
- After you have selected the classes, click "**Submit Schedule**". This tab will allow you to print a copy of the classes you selected as well as submit the schedule to Josie Geishirt to review, approve and lock

**Kindergarten Jumpstart 1** (for students going into K) Kurtz  
This class will run from 8:00-12:00. When registering it will automatically register you for all three periods. **You can only register for ONE SESSION** (either Session One **OR** Session Two) Kindergarten Jumpstart is specially designed to prepare children for entering school in the fall. This class is filled with readiness lessons in math and language arts. Children are engaged in school-day routines, hands-on-centers and activities to further develop fine motor and social skills. **Min 10 / Max 15 Course Fee \$3.00**

**Travel the World 1** (1st-3rd grade) Grimm
