



# Before and After School Care for Wisconsin Heights School District

## The Lifecycle Kids Program

It is the philosophy of Lifecycle Kids to provide high quality childcare in a nurturing, creative, healthy and enriching environment. With Lifecycle Kids, children are provided far more than after school babysitting. We are an extension to the school, offering a safe and encouraging environment for children to explore and learn through play. Children are offered opportunity to create artwork, develop science experiments, build towers, imagine new adventures, make music, play games, dress up, play outside and more. Our program is a wonderful complement to the structure of school, allowing children to continue learning through play and giving them a daily outlet for individual exploration and physical activity.

Our before school program opens at 6am and ends when the children are dismissed to their classroom for school or taken to the bus to go to Mazomanie Elementary. All parents must escort their child into the building and check in with Lifecycle Kids staff when dropping their child off for care. After school care begins after dismissal as the children check in with Lifecycle Kids staff and closes at 6pm. Children in the 4K program are met at their classroom by Lifecycle Kids staff and brought to the wrap around care classroom.

Children are provided breakfast if attending before school care before 7am. In addition, a healthy snack and milk are provided to children after school. Children in the 4K program either purchase lunch through the school lunch program or bring their own lunch which meets the USDA guidelines. On no school days, children will need to bring lunch, however breakfast and snacks will be provided.

## Tuition and Fees

Tuition is charged weekly before care is provided. Tuition is collected through an automatic payment system. Additionally, a non-refundable \$30 application fee is charged when you apply for care. Upon acceptance into the program, enrollment paperwork must be completed and



submitted with payment of first week tuition and a \$25 supply fee. These charges are non-refundable if you chose to withdraw your child from care.

We provide a variety of care options to meet the needs of families on school days as well as during school breaks. Our options allow for you to choose a plan which provides care for school and no school days for a set price or only on school days for a lower price. If space is available on no school days or during school breaks, these can be added.

### Before and After School Care

Before school 5 days	<b>\$25</b>
After School Only (5 days) <i>no care on no school days, early release, snow days, spring break, winter break</i>	<b>\$80</b>
After school (5 days) and no school days <i>including early release, snow day, spring break, winter break</i>	<b>\$100</b>
After school daily rate <i>available on a space available basis</i>	<b>\$25</b>
Full day daily rate <i>available on a space available basis</i>	<b>\$60</b>
Full week all day care <i>available on a space available basis</i>	<b>\$230</b>

### 4K Wrap Around Care

Before and after 4K (5 days) <i>only on school days</i>	<b>\$200</b>
Before and after 4K (5 days) and no school <i>Including all no school days and snow days</i>	<b>\$230</b>
Before and after 4K (3days) <i>only on school days</i>	<b>\$150</b>
Before afternoon 4K <i>Only on school days 6am-12:30pm</i>	<b>\$120</b>
Before afternoon 4K <i>Including all no school days and snow days</i>	<b>\$140</b>
After AM 4K <i>Only on school days</i>	<b>\$110</b>
After AM 4K <i>Including all no school days and snow days</i>	<b>\$130</b>
Daily rate (Before and After 4K)	<b>\$60</b>



## Summer Care

Summer (full summer 12 weeks)	<b>\$2400</b>
Summer full week <i>available on a space available basis</i>	<b>\$230 per week</b>
Summer daily rate <i>available on a space available basis</i>	<b>\$60</b>

Keeping with our belief that all children deserve access to high quality care regardless of parental ability to private pay, we participate in the Wisconsin Shares program as an active participant in Wisconsin's YoungStar program. This program provides a subsidy to parents to cover part of their childcare expenses in an effort to make quality childcare affordable to children whose family do not have the financial ability to cover costs in a self-pay environment.
