



# 4K AND SCHOOL AGE CARE

## The Lifecycle Kids Program

It is the philosophy of Lifecycle Kids to provide high quality childcare in a nurturing, creative, healthy, and enriching environment. With Lifecycle Kids, children are provided far more than babysitting. We are an extension to the school, offering a safe and encouraging environment for children to explore and learn through play. Children are offered opportunities to create artwork, develop science experiments, build towers, imagine new adventures, make music, play games, dress up, play outside and more. Our program is a wonderful complement to the structure of school, allowing children to continue learning through play and giving them a daily outlet for individual exploration and physical activity.

During the time of virtual or hybrid learning, we assist or facilitate the opportunity for children to participate in their scheduled virtual classroom. While we do our best to help your child with completing assignments correctly, we cannot provide one on one tutoring for your child, and we will not be able to ensure all assignments are correct or that your child is achieving specific grades. Your child's progress is still a partnership between you, your child and the district teacher.

During virtual learning, we ask that you also provide us with a copy of your child's classroom schedule and your child's passwords to help us better assist them with online learning. We will have a folder for each child to keep this information in.

In addition to virtual learning, as well as on non-school days and in-person learning days, we will incorporate our own thematic activities that will keep your child engaged in learning and exploration while in our care. Activities will include art, group games, dramatic play, science, indoor and outdoor play as well as academic activities such as writing, read aloud and math. We will also work on life skills to help teach children skills such as making a lunch, tying shoes, community service projects like food drives and making things for others.



We are a state licensed childcare facility, so apart from virtual learning required by the parents and schools, we will limit access to electronics and only use them for additional learning opportunities. Lifecycle Kids will do our best to protect each child's electronics and other personal items, but we are not responsible for lost, stolen or broken items. Children will be required to provide all necessary supplies for completing their class work through virtual learning.

We will do our best to provide your child with the atmosphere and support your child needs to successfully complete school assignments, however, you and your child's teacher will be ultimately responsible to ensure your child completes assignments and is progressing at the most developmentally appropriate level.

As for our youngest group of students, the 4K children, we are extremely excited to provide activities to prepare them for Kindergarten. We will coordinate with the 4K teachers to match our activities with the skills that are being taught in 4K. We are confident we have the skills, materials, and experience to prepare engaging learning opportunities for your 4K child to be Kindergarten ready. We will learn letters, numbers, our names, letter sounds, shapes, colors, sorting and so many other things. We will learn all topics through a thematic unit and through play as that is most developmentally appropriate. Aside from any screen time used by the school district, there will be no screen time in our 4K classroom unless for educational research purposes.

Our program will open at 7am and close at 5pm. All parents must escort their child into the building and check in with Lifecycle Kids staff when dropping their child off for care. Children who are receiving in-person learning with the school and are being bussed to the school, must coordinate with the school to have their child get from the bus to their Lifecycle Kids classroom.

Children are provided breakfast and snack through Lifecycle Kids. Children who attend the morning session of in-person school at Mazomanie Elementary, will not have time for breakfast before getting on the school bus in the morning. Families will be required to provide lunch for their child while in care. Lunches need to meet the USDA guidelines and not require any heating or refrigeration. Please send your child's lunch in a labeled lunchbox to be stored in their bin or backpack.



## Tuition and Fees

Tuition is charged weekly before care is provided. Tuition is collected through an automatic payment system. Tuition can be paid using a bank account or credit/debit card. If you choose to use a credit or debit card a 3% service fee will be added to your bill. Additionally, a non-refundable \$30 application fee is charged when you apply for care. Upon acceptance into the program, enrollment paperwork must be completed and submitted with payment of first week tuition and a \$25 supply fee. These charges are non-refundable if you chose to withdraw your child from care.
