Since September 14 . . .



- The 2020-21 school year started and we are now four weeks into the academic year!
- Feedback was sought from the teaching staff.
- We added more students to our in person support hubs.
- BE elementary is working to bring in small cohorts of 4K students in a hybrid model.
- Planning has begun for a Studio/Lab Schedule for early to mid October for High School students.

The Plan - as approved on July 27, 2020



- We will start on September 1, 2020 in an Enhanced Online Environment PK-12 grade.
- This will be our delivery method through at least November 4, 2020 (end of the first academic quarter).
- Enhanced = refined online learning experience and in-person services provided for specific populations by invite (special services).

Food Service



- Important change from USDA
 - Beginning Monday, September 14, the Wisconsin Heights School District will offer FREE meals to all children, 18 and under in the community, through December 31, 2020, or until available funding runs out.
- Participation supports our school meals programs
- Curbside pick up
 - Mondays from 2:30 to 3:30 or 5 to 6 PM at all three schools
- Meals are pre-ordered utilizing a [weekly Google Form](#) and [monthly menu](#)
- **Meals served to date: 1,557 breakfasts and 1,671 lunches**

A socially distanced space where students can quietly work online, without distractions, receiving just-in-time redirection, reteaching and support.

- High School - 12



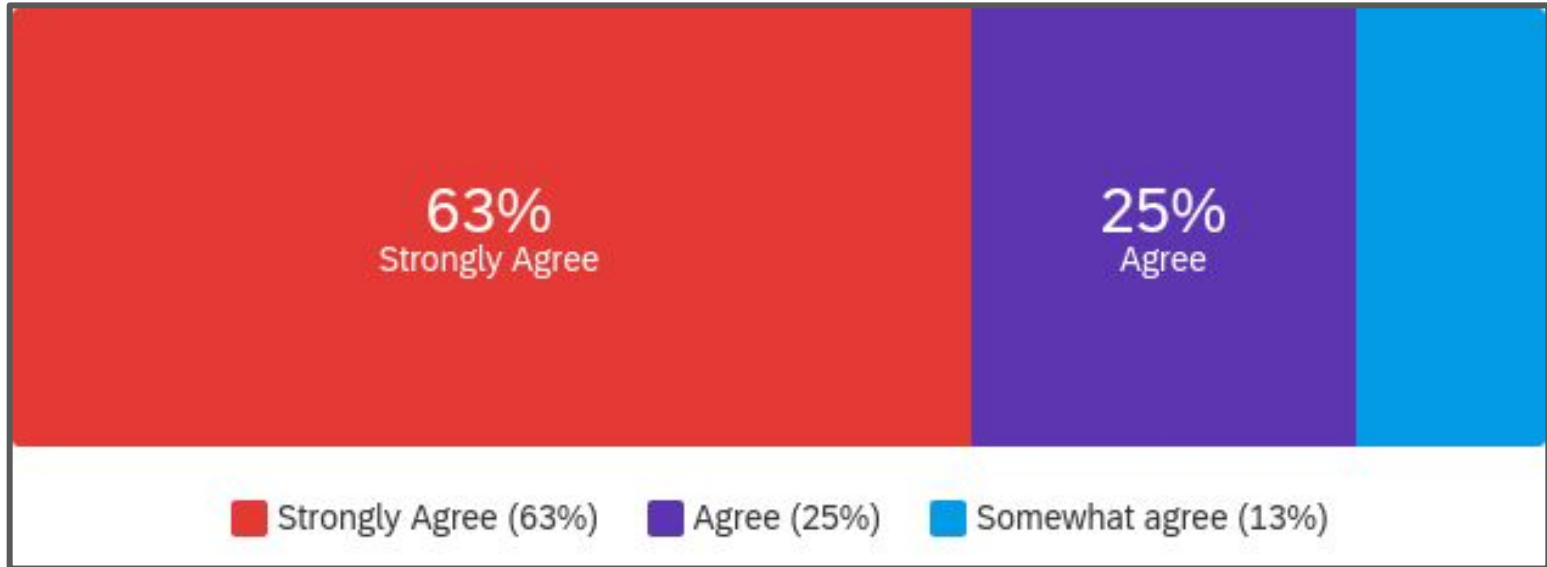
Black Earth In-Person Plan

- Parent survey went out to 4K and Kindergarten families on Friday, Sept 18.
 - Asked if parents were interested in their child participating in a hybrid model of instruction (M-T or Th-F).
 - 4K Results:
 - More families wanted students in a hybrid model.
 - Kindergarten Results:
 - More families wanted to remain online.
 - 4K will begin in a hybrid model of instruction on Monday, Oct 12.
 - Ordering classroom materials.
 - Arranging classrooms to support social distancing.
 - Communicating with families regarding which cohort they will be in.
 - Determining how to continue supporting students online.
 - Creating visuals for students prior to coming to school.
 - Preparing materials for student use.

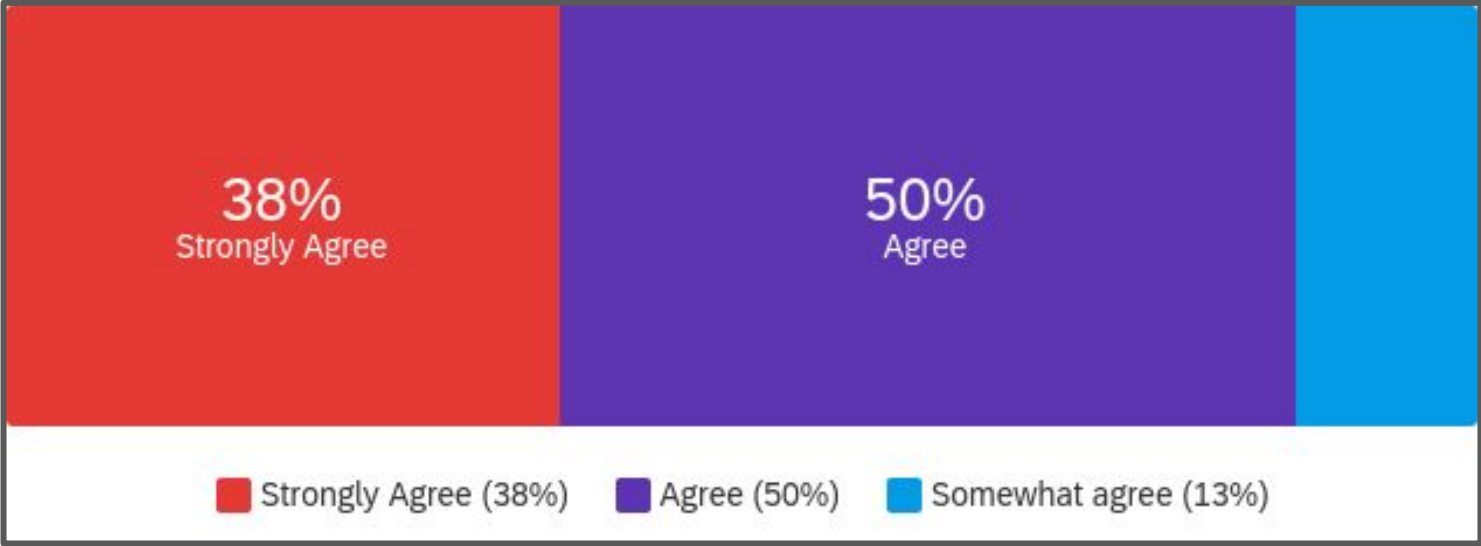

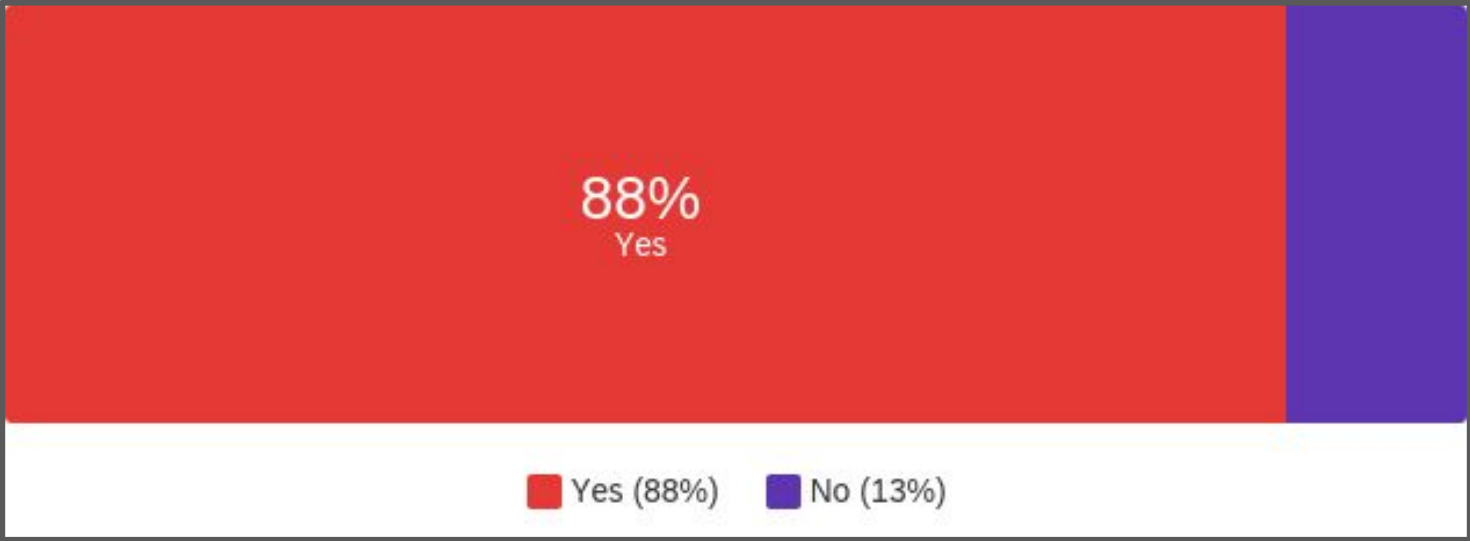

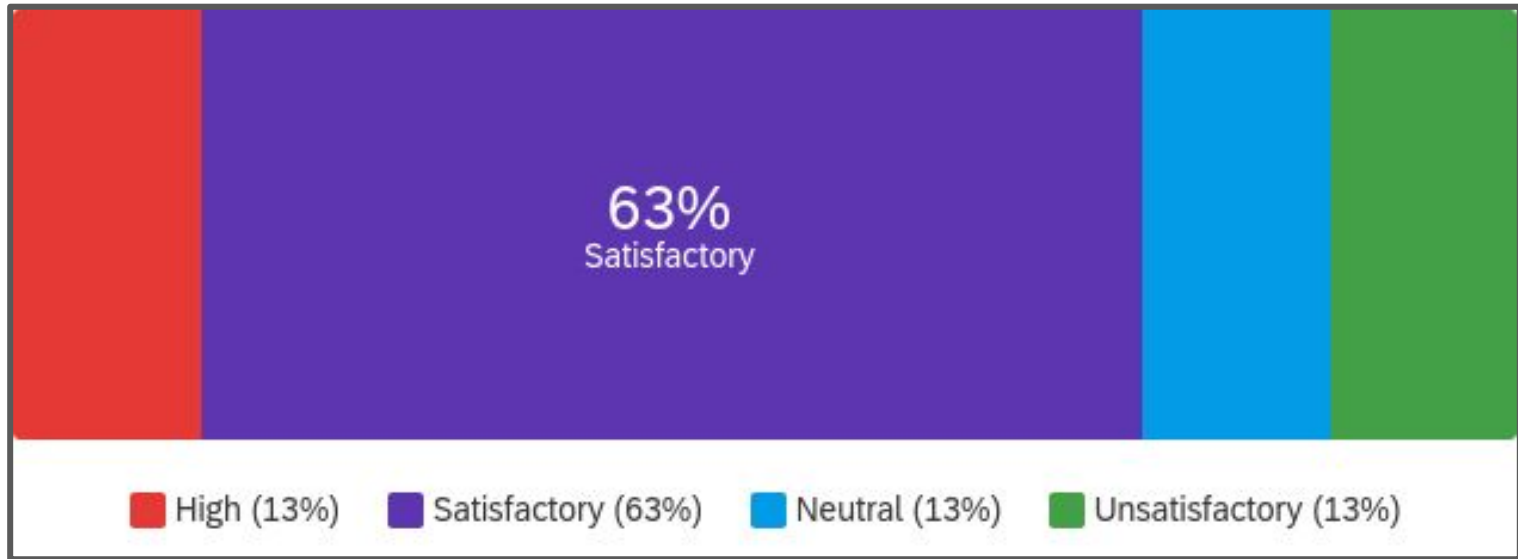

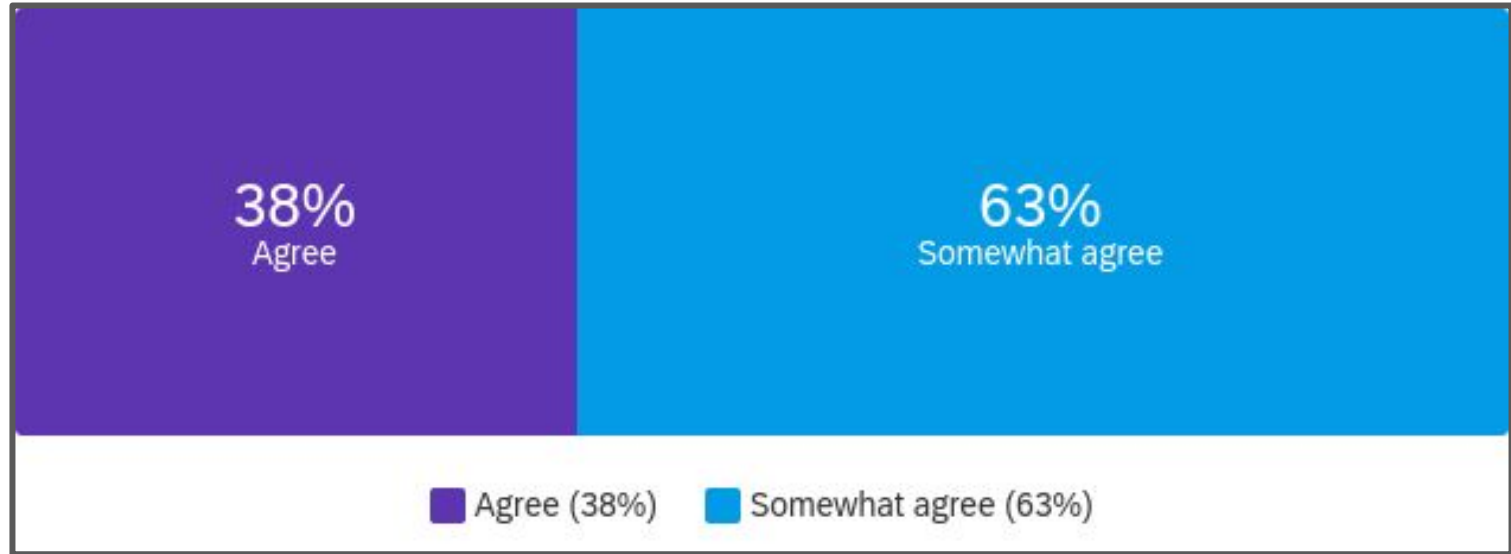

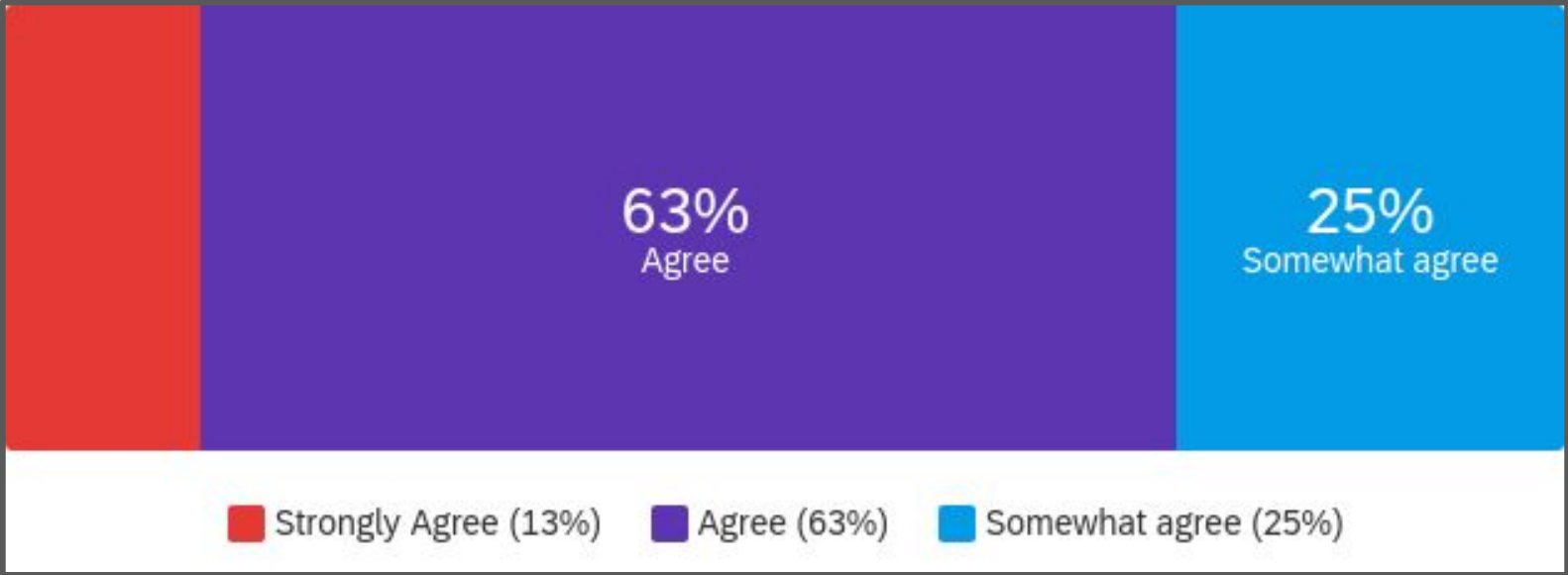

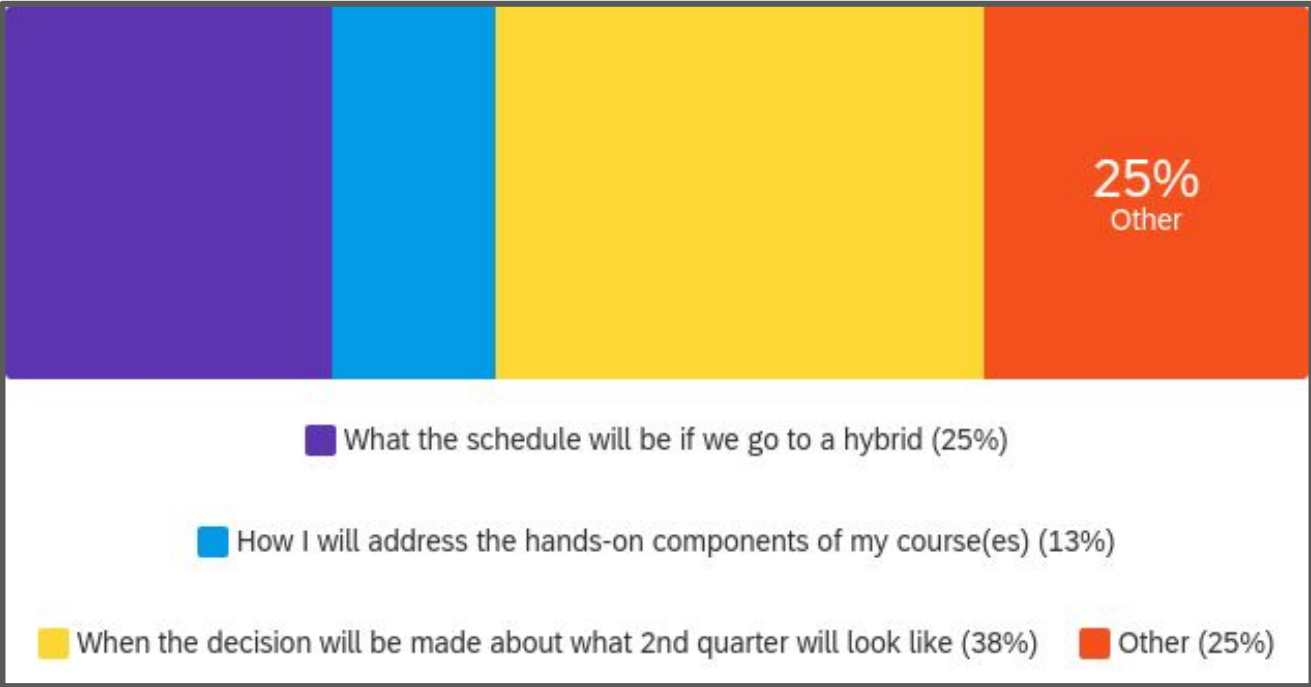

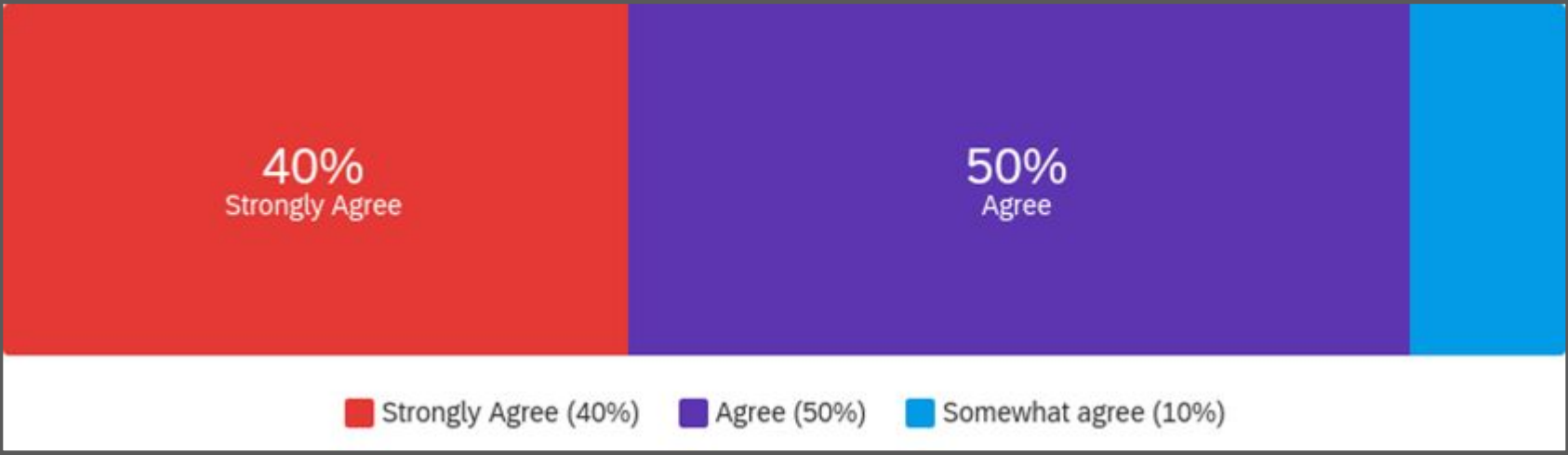
As we approach 2nd quarter, what concerns do you have?

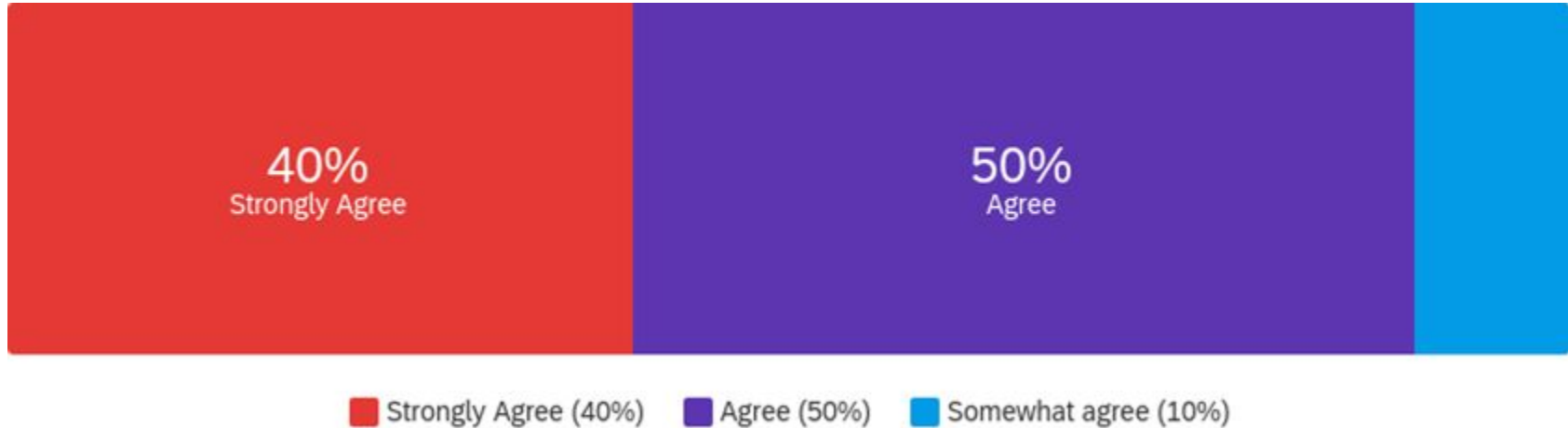

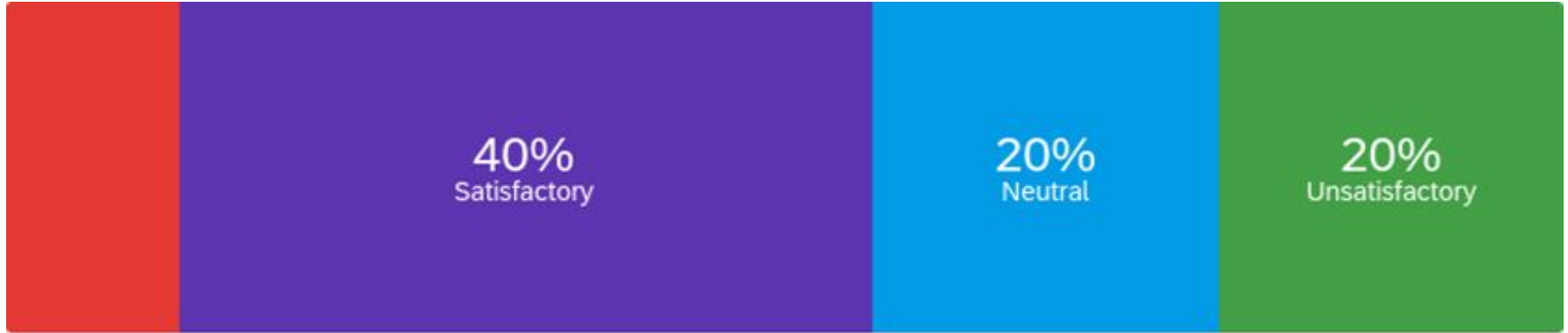

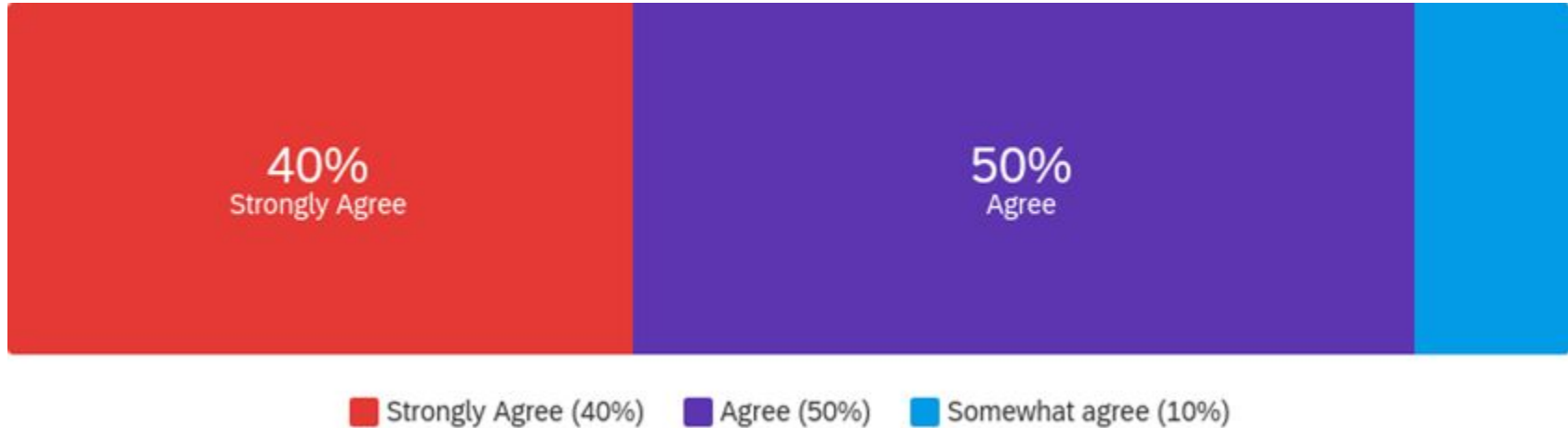

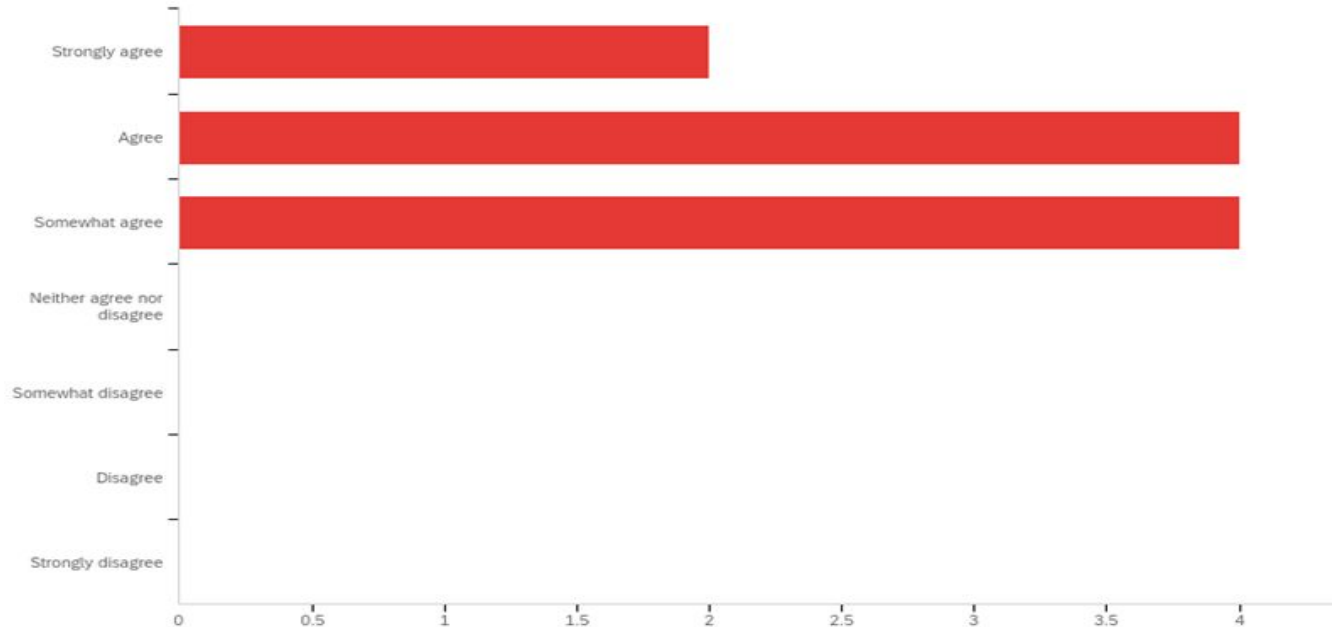

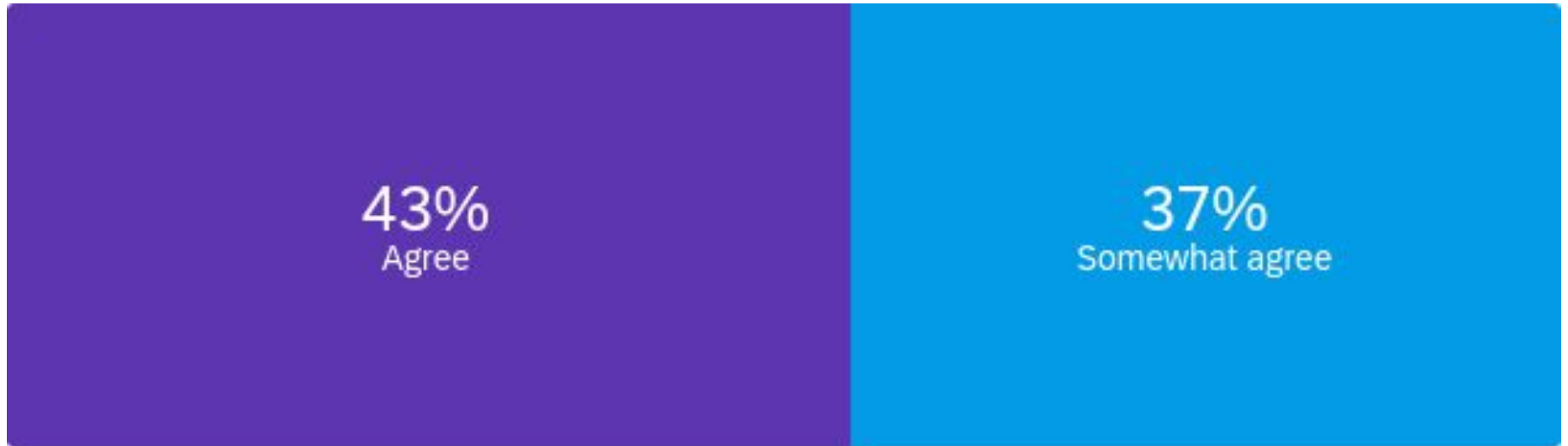

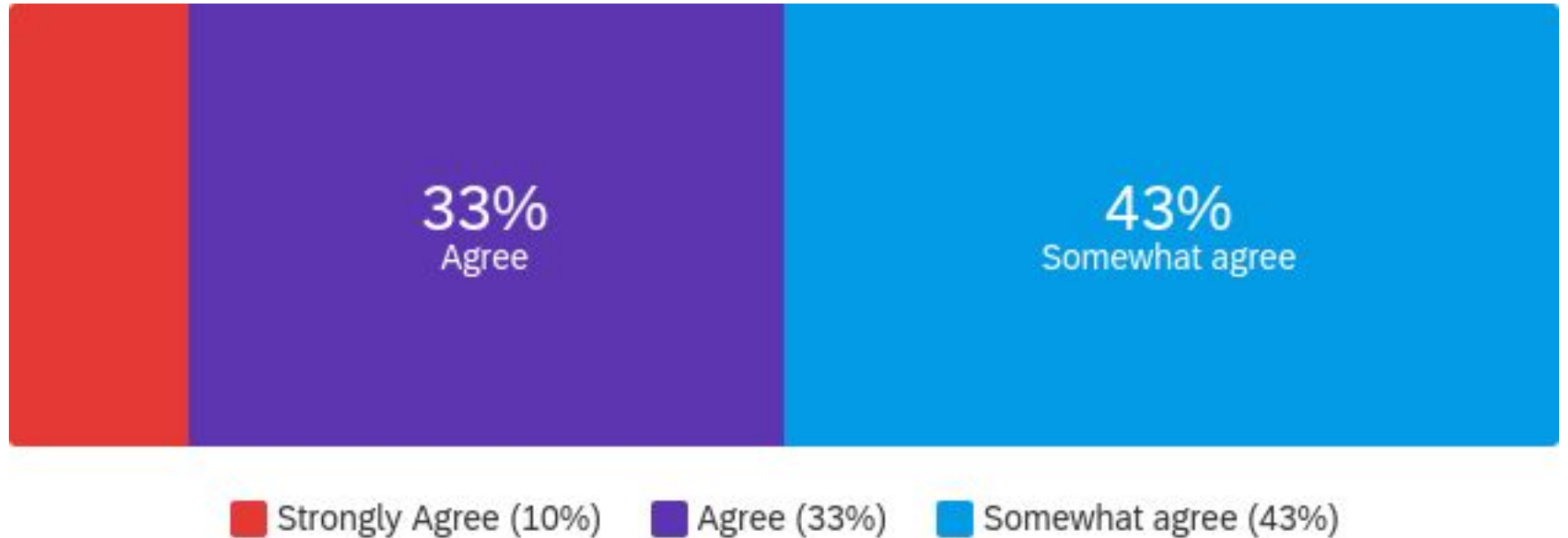

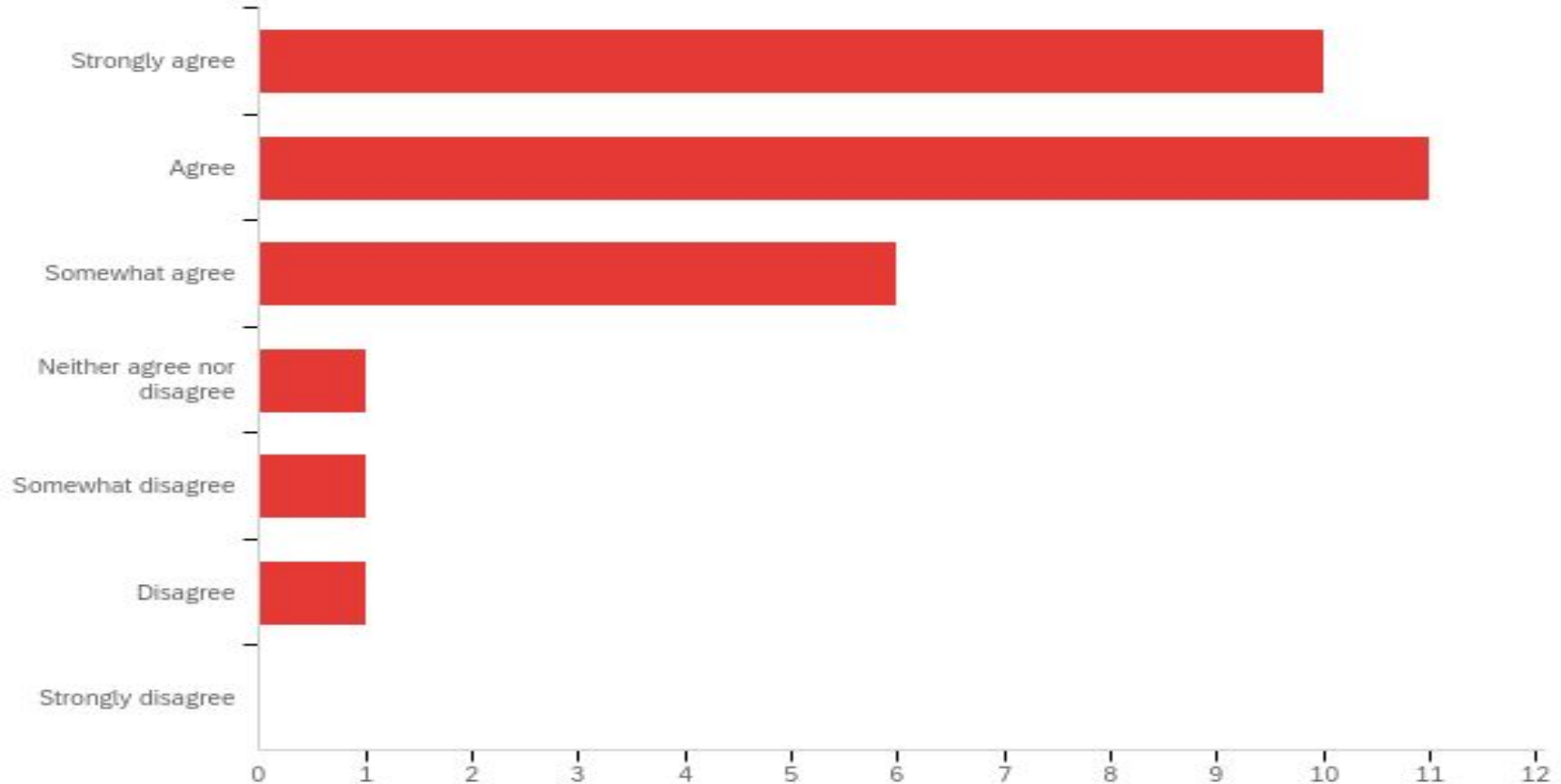
