The Plan - as approved on July 27, 2020



- We will start on September 1, 2020 in an Enhanced Online Environment PK-12 grade.
- This will be our delivery method through at least November 4, 2020 (end of the first academic quarter).
- Enhanced = refined online learning experience and in-person services provided for specific populations by invite (special services).

Amendment to Dane County Emergency Order #9



- Allows for in-person instruction for students in any grade with a disability and/or an Individualized Education Program (IEP) who, due to their unique needs, may need to receive in-person instruction.
- This order allowed us to support students with IEPs and 504 plans in-person, online at Mazomanie and the MS/HS.
- Less than 10 students at each location receiving services.

Student Support Hubs



A socially distanced space where students can quietly work online, without distractions, receiving just-in-time redirection, reteaching and support.

- Approximately 20 students are participating at Black Earth Elementary, 10 students at Mazomanie.
- 10 students in person, online at MS/HS with additional virtual student support.

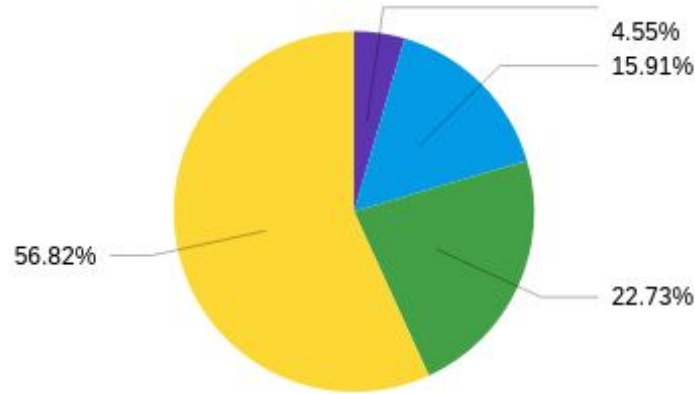

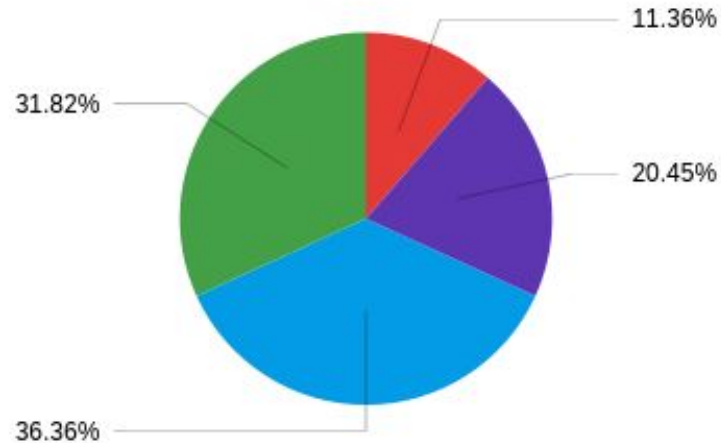
1. I am excited to be back in school!

2. What grade are you in?

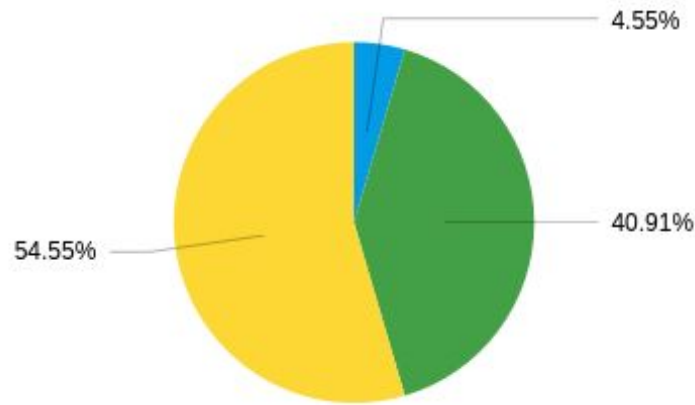

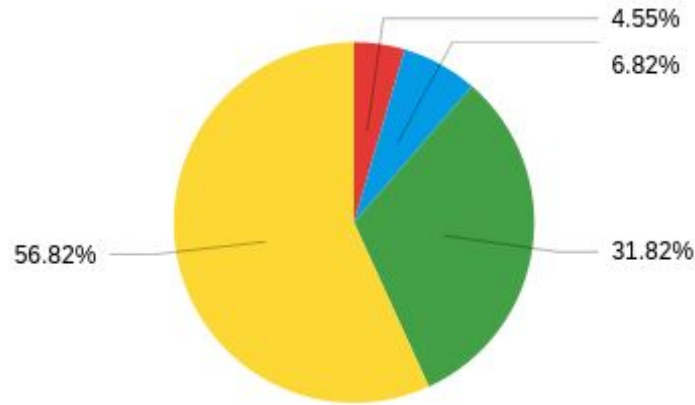
3. My teacher is getting to know me.

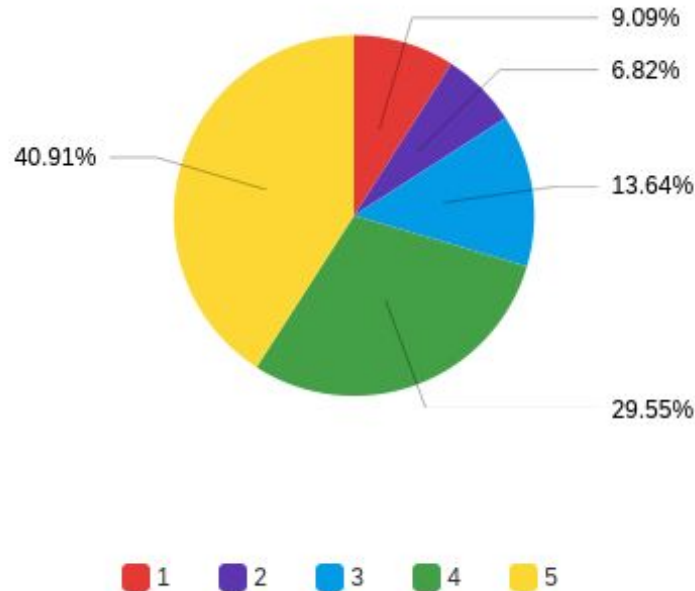
