State of Wisconsin Driver Education Requirements: The student must be 15 years old to enter classroom. The student must be a minimum of 15-1/2 years old to obtain an Instructional Permit from the State of Wisconsin DMV. To obtain the Instructional Permit, the student **MUST** be enrolled for the Behind the Wheel course and show proof of passing the classroom or on-line course. Once a student turns 18 years old and graduates from high school they are no longer eligible for this program.

WISCONSIN HEIGHTS SCHOOL DISTRICT DRIVER'S EDUCATION PROGRAM

CESA #2 is assisting Wisconsin Heights High School with the Drivers' Education Program. For your convenience, students may attain a Wisconsin driver's license through a program offered by CESA #2, at the Wisconsin Heights High Schools' campus, both during the school year and during the summer. Both the classroom classes and Behind the Wheel lessons are taught at Wisconsin Heights High School. CESA #2 follows all policies and procedures that are set by the Wisconsin Heights High School.

Driver Education is a foundation course, which teaches the theory of responsible driving, defensive driving, and emphasis is placed on the introduction of the proper safety mechanics of safe driving. The course is designed to improve the student's knowledge of traffic safety and to become safe operators of motor vehicles. The course covers all areas of vehicle operation, legal obligations, maintenance, effects of alcohol and other drugs, with a strong emphasis on distractive driving.

PROGRAM COST

Traditional Classroom \$150.00- Driver Education is a foundation course which teaches the theory of responsible driving. Emphasis is placed upon introduction of mechanics of driving, execution of most driving operations, and a thorough understanding of rules of safe driving. We provide 30 hours of classroom instruction. Not eligible for MV3001 Form for the instructional permit until successful completion of the course and enrollment for Behind the Wheel.

Students that attend the class without registering with CESA 2 will be dismissed from class and not receive instruction.

CESA 2 requires information on any special needs that your child might have i.e. hearing impaired, ADD, IEP's, juvenile diabetes, etc. We will do our best to accommodate the needs for your child's success.

Online Class Course \$175.00- The Online Driver Education course offered by CESA 2 provides a unique opportunity for students that have busy schedules to learn critical skills needed to become a safe, low-risk driver. Our program is one of few that meet the National and State Standards for online learning. Your child will have an instructor to work with them throughout the course. Not eligible for MV3001 Form for the instructional permit until successful completion of the course and enrollment for Behind the Wheel.

Online Course Required Textbook: This course is based on the AAA's book, How to Drive. **This book must be purchased** and is not provided through CESA 2. How to Drive is offered as a soft-cover book or an e-book. For more information regarding CESA 2 online course and links to purchase the required text book, please access our website at <http://cesa2.com>. To ensure you are purchasing the correct textbook, please do not order until you receive the email containing the link to order it.

There is a \$50.00 fee for all on-line extensions.

Behind the Wheel & BTW Safety and Cleaning Fee \$265.00- This course is for students between the age of 15.5 and 18 who have completed the 30-hour classroom portion, or the online course and need to fulfill the Behind the Wheel requirements for the State of Wisconsin. The MV 3001 Form will be issued to the student to obtain their instructional permit. This form will expire 60 days from the date by the signature at the bottom. The Behind the Wheel course includes six hours of in-car training and 6 hours of observation. Your student must successfully complete both the classroom and Behind the Wheel requirements to be eligible for the electronic DMV completion and the Wisconsin Licensing Driving Skill Test.

A \$23.00 No-Show fee will be imposed for any missed Behind the Wheel Lesson. The fee will be due prior to next lesson.

The Behind the Wheel (BTW) training **MUST** start within 13 months from the end of the classroom. If this does not happen the State of Wisconsin will require the student to take a 10-hour refresher course. The Temporary License will expire. We will not renew it until the 10-hour course is completed.

We can offer a 10-hour online refresher course, or the student can retake the entire classroom. There is no additional cost for retaking the classroom. Attendance is mandatory. The cost for the online refresher is \$75.00.

Refunds: No refunds or transfer of registration fees between students will be issued after one year from the date of the original registration. There is a \$50.00 processing fee for all refunds during the one-year period. All service fees for credit card transactions are non-refundable.

If your student has completed any portion of the online course, we will also withhold a portion of the registration fee for payment to the online instructor's time spent working with your student. The cost for the textbook is non-refundable.
