



4K AND SCHOOL AGE CARE

The Lifecycle Kids Program

It is the philosophy of Lifecycle Kids to provide high quality childcare in a nurturing, creative, healthy and enriching environment. With Lifecycle Kids, children are provided far more than babysitting. We are an extension to the school, offering a safe and encouraging environment for children to explore and learn through play. Children are offered opportunity to create artwork, develop science experiments, build towers, imagine new adventures, make music, play games, dress up, play outside and more. Our program is a wonderful complement to the structure of school, allowing children to continue learning through play and giving them a daily outlet for individual exploration and physical activity.

Activities will include art, group games, dramatic play, science, indoor and outdoor play as well as academic activities such as writing, read aloud and math. We also will be working on life skills to help teach children skills such as making a lunch, tying shoes, counting money and buying items from a store, making a lemonade stand and selling items, washing dishes and others.

We are a state licensed childcare facility, so apart from virtual learning required by the parents and schools, we will limit access to electronics and only use them for additional learning opportunities. Lifecycle Kids will do our best to protect each child's electronics, but we are not responsible for lost, stolen or broken items. Children will be required to provide all necessary supplies for completing their class work through virtual learning.

We will do our best to provide your child with the atmosphere and support your child needs to successfully complete school assignments, however, you and your child's teacher will be ultimately responsible to ensure your child completes assignments and is progressing at the most developmentally appropriate level.



As for our youngest group of students, the 4K children, we are extremely excited to provide activities to prepare them for Kindergarten. We will learn letters, numbers, our names, letter sounds, shapes, colors, sorting and so many other things. We will learn all topics through a thematic unit and through play as that is most developmentally appropriate. Aside from any screen time used by the school district, there will be no screen time in our 4K classroom unless for educational research purposes.

Our program will open at 6am and close at 6pm. All parents must escort their child into the building and check in with Lifecycle Kids staff when dropping their child off for care. Children who are being bussed to the school, must coordinate with the school to have their child get from the bus to their Lifecycle Kids classroom.

Children are provided breakfast and snack through Lifecycle Kids. Families will be required to provide lunch for their child while in care. Lunches need to meet the USDA guidelines, not require any heating or refrigeration. Please send your child's lunch in a labeled lunchbox to be stored in their bin or backpack.

Tuition and Fees

Tuition is charged weekly before care is provided. Tuition is collected through an automatic payment system. Additionally, a non-refundable \$30 application fee is charged when you apply for care. Upon acceptance into the program, enrollment paperwork must be completed and submitted with payment of first week tuition and a \$25 supply fee. These charges are non-refundable if you chose to withdraw your child from care.

We provide a variety of care options to meet the needs of families on school days as well as during school breaks. Our options allow for you to choose a plan which provides care for school and no school days for a set price or only on school days for a lower price. If space is available on no school days or during school breaks, these can be added.

Full-Time care 5 days per week	\$240
Part-Time care (if space is available)	\$50 per day

Keeping with our belief that all children deserve access to high quality care regardless of parental ability to private pay, we participate in the Wisconsin Shares program as an active participant in Wisconsin's YoungStar program. This program provides a subsidy to parents to cover part of their childcare expenses in an effort to make quality childcare affordable to children whose family do not have the financial ability to cover costs in a self-pay environment.
