

Test to Stay Program

Unvaccinated student that are a close contact to a positive case **at school** could come to school as long as all the following are true:

- The close contact is not to a household member
- They are **asymptomatic** (if any symptoms develop they need to stay home and get a PCR or NAAT test)
- They wear a well fitting **mask for 10 days** after the exposure
- They **agree to 2 rapid tests** at school during the 10 days of the quarantine.

Testing for test to stay

Two rapid tests would be completed during the 10 day time period. The first test should be done on day 3 or 4 after the exposure and the second test done between 5-7 days after the exposure.

Parents will need to complete the [Online Registration](#) the day before EACH test is to be done and email the QR code to Katy Howe, School Nurse (khowe@wisheights.k12.wi.us), and Matt Green, Student Services Director (mgreen@wisheights.k12.wi.us). Results will be sent to the email used to register.

If a student tests positive they will be sent home and have to isolate. If they test negative they can remain at school. Students should go directly to the office the morning of their test, do the test and then can go to class if negative.

For close contacts that were notified of the exposure between 5-10 days after last contact then only 1 test result is needed.
